Any of the above could be a sign of bad gas and you should change your gas before the sled develops more serious problems. 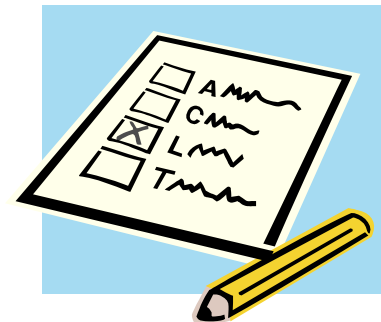
